

INTERACTIVE TOUR

[BIG Projects]

- 1** Create a map by using a Google maps screen shot and tracing over it in Adobe Photoshop; or vectorise a map using Adobe Illustrator; or draw a map and digitise it
- 2** Plan your interactive tour. Decide on the locations, stories and information you want to share and how to share them - text, photos, audio, video?
- 3** Capture the content needed for each step of the tour.
- 4** Export, name and create a file on the computer for all the different elements
- 5** Create an AppBook and upload all the content required. Don't forget to save the project as soon as you start
- 6** In SETTINGS, un-tick 'Enable swipe navigation' – this AppBook is not going to be chronological
- 7** Arrange the content for each page of the AppBook
- 8** Link all the pages for navigation. Include an exit button and the option to return to the map/go back on each page
- 9** Test the tour in the AppBooks app to find out if there are any glitches to iron out or refine
- 10** Collect appropriate permission releases
- 11** Save and publish!



Use AppBooks to make an interactive map of your community, or of a location that you want to share stories and information about

You'll need

- AppBooks and internet
- Adobe Photoshop
- Device for capturing photos
- Photo editing app like Snapseed
- Device for capturing audio
- Device microphone (like RODE smartlav+)

- Capturing and editing audio
- Capturing and editing images
- Screen literacy and getting online
